**AMENDMENT TO APPLICATION OF VERIZON CALIFORNIA INC. (U-1002-C)
TO DISCONTINUE ANNUAL SHARED ASSET METHODOLOGY REPORTING
REQUIREMENT ADOPTED IN DECISION 04-03-038 AS THE REPORT NO LONGER
SERVES ANY USEFUL PURPOSE**

Pursuant to Rule 1.12 of the Commission’s Rules of Practice and Procedure, and at the request of the assigned Administrative Law Judge, Verizon California Inc. (U-1002-C) hereby supplements the above-referenced Application to include additional information requested by the ALJ on two items discussed below. As the time has already passed for any interested party to protest the original Application—which no party did—the ALJ “may limit or prohibit any further ... protest” to this amendment pursuant to Rule 1.12. Verizon respectfully asserts that there is no need for the Commission to provide further opportunity to protest this amended Application since the information contained herein is wholly supplemental in nature and does not alter the nature or substance of the relief requested in the original Application, which as noted is uncontested.

First, the ALJ requested a list of Verizon affiliates to which the approved shared asset methodology currently applies. Verizon hereby provides the requested list in the attached **Appendix A**.

Second, the ALJ requested confirmation that the administrative assets subject to the approved shared asset methodology are exempt from Public Utilities Code section 851 requirements pursuant to Decision 10-05-019. Verizon hereby provides such

confirmation. Verizon directs the Commission's attention to Ordering Paragraphs 1 and 2 of Decision 10-05-019, which among other things exempt administrative assets such as land and buildings (FCC Account 2121), including portions thereof, that are not currently used to provide collocation services or that do not have space reserved in them to provide such collocation services in the future. The office space jointly used by Verizon's service company affiliates under the shared asset methodology falls within the scope of this exemption. In addition, Ordering Paragraph 1 exempts office equipment (FCC Account 2123) from section 851 requirements. Accordingly, all assets subject to the shared asset methodology are exempt from section 851 requirements.

Verizon stands ready to provide any additional information that the ALJ deems necessary to approve this Application. Verizon respectfully renews its request that the Commission issue a decision in this proceeding by year's end to avoid unnecessary uncertainty regarding whether Verizon must prepare the next shared asset report due February 1, 2011.

LIST OF SERVICE COMPANY AFFILIATES CURRENTLY SUBJECT TO THE SHARED ASSET METHODOLOGY

In Decision 06-10-003, the Commission authorized Verizon to extend the shared asset methodology, previously approved in Decision 04-03-038, to the following service company affiliates,¹ in addition to “other service companies that fall within the FCC’s definition of ‘service company’ and may be formed in future corporate reorganizations.” Pursuant to such authorization, Verizon currently applies the shared asset methodology to the following service company affiliates:

- Verizon Corporate Resources Group LLC
- Verizon Corporate Services Corp.
- Verizon Corporate Services Group Inc. (formerly GTE Service Corp.)
- Verizon Data Services LLC (formerly Verizon Data Services Inc. (“VDSI”))
- Verizon Services Corp.
- Verizon Services Operations Inc.
- Verizon Services Organization Inc. (formerly GTE Consolidated Services Incorporated (“CSI”))

In addition, Verizon intends to update the shared asset methodology effective January 1, 2011 to include the following additional service company affiliates:

- Verizon Business Network Services Inc.
- Verizon Enterprise Delivery LLC

Please note that some of the legal names of the entities specified in Verizon’s May 8, 2006 application have changed, e.g., “New Legal Entity #4” is now Verizon Services Operations Inc. Shown above are all Verizon service company affiliates currently subject to the shared asset methodology, with their current legal names, and including those additional service companies later added as they fall within the FCC’s definition of “service company,” as authorized by Decision 06-10-003.
