

On October 1, 2010, San Diego Gas & Electric Company (SDG&E) filed an application with the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) for approval of its forecasted electric procurement revenue requirement for 2011, referred to as SDG&E's 2011 Energy Resource Recovery Account (ERRA) Forecast Application (A.10-10-001). SDG&E requested approval of a forecasted 2011 ERRA revenue requirement of \$737.2 million and a 2011 Competition Transition Charge (CTC) Revenue Requirement of \$31.6 million, a decrease from 2010 levels. These revenue requirements cover the costs of acquiring power for retail customers, including costs to purchase power under contracts with various power suppliers, California Independent System Operator charges and collateral requirements associated with electric procurement, as well as the cost responsibility of Direct Access (DA) customers and Community Choice Aggregation customers for above-market procurement costs to ensure bundled customer indifference.

On January 14, 2011, SDG&E filed an amended application and testimony, adjusting for the yearly update to market benchmark data. The market benchmark data is an input value in the calculation of the CTC and is based on the average forward energy prices recorded for a 31 day period. The update does not change the total revenue requirement, but does shift cost responsibility among the different customer classes, resulting in an increase for DA customers, since DA customers do not purchase commodity services from SDG&E and only experience the impacts associated with changes to SDG&E's Utility Distribution Company (UDC) rates. This update modifies SDG&E's requested approval of a forecasted 2011 ERRA revenue requirement of \$755.4 million and a 2011 Competition Transition Charge Revenue Requirement of \$63.3 million, a decrease overall to total rates (UDC and commodity) from current levels but an increase to UDC rates.

**ILLUSTRATIVE IMPACT ON ELECTRIC RATES AND BILLS**

If the CPUC approves SDG&E's request, a typical bundled non-CARE residential customer living in the inland climate zone and using 500 kilowatt-hours per month could see a monthly summer bill decrease of 0.89%, or \$0.66. A typical monthly electric bill could decrease from \$81.05 to \$80.39. For DA customers, the UDC rate impacts on a class average basis are presented below. The percentages shown do not necessarily reflect the changes that you may see on your bill. Changes in individual bills will also depend on how much electricity each customer uses and when it is used.


