**NOTICE OF EX PARTE COMMUNICATION
OF THE DIVISION OF RATEPAYER ADVOCATES**

In accordance with Rule 8.3 of the Rules of Practice and Procedure of the California Public Utilities Commission, the Division of Ratepayer Advocates (“DRA”) submits this notice of an ex parte communication.

The communication consisted of a meeting between DRA representative Harvey Y. Morris and Commissioner Dian Grueneich’s advisors Jamie Fordyce and Matthew Tisdale. The meeting occurred on the fifth floor of CPUC headquarters on February 19, 2010, at approximately 11:00 a.m.

DRA discussed its position that gas AMI (advanced metering infrastructure) had speculative benefits, and requested an all-party meeting with Commissioner Grueneich to discuss the Proposed Decision (“PD”) and Alternate PD in the above-captioned proceeding, Southern California Gas Company’s application for approval of a gas-only AMI system. No written materials were used in the communication.
