**SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON COMPANY (U 338-E) PROOF OF

Southern California Edison Company (SCE) hereby provides proof of compliance with Rule 3.2(d) of the California Public Utilities Commission’s Rules of Practice and Procedure.

Rule 3.2(d) requires SCE to “furnish to its customers affected by the proposed increase notice of its application either by mailing such notice postage prepaid to such customers or by including such notice with the regular bill for charges transmitted to such customers” within 45 days after the filing of the Application. As required by Rule 3.2(d), a notice of proposed increase

was furnished to SCE's customers within 45 days after SCE filed the Application by including such notice with the regular bill for charges transmitted to such customers.

Attachment A is the Declaration of Michelle Esperanza, certifying that the notice of the Application was provided to all SCE customers by means of inclusion with the regular monthly bills provided to customers. The notice was also available online at www.sce.com/notices through the entire notice period. Attachment B is a copy of the notice.

Rule 3.2(d) also requires that the applicant file a proof of compliance within 10 days after mailing the notice. The last date that the notice was mailed was November 20, 2009. SCE files this proof of compliance one-day late, which was necessary to prepare Attachment A, the Declaration of Michelle Esperanza.

NOTIFICATION OF APPLICATION BY SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON COMPANY (SCE) FOR EXPEDITED AUTHORIZATION TO CHANGE RESIDENTIAL ELECTRIC RATES EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2010, AS PERMITTED BY NEWLY ENACTED PUBLIC UTILITIES CODE SECTION 739.9

APPLICATION NO. A.09-10-014

On October 14, 2009, SCE filed an Application with the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) requesting expedited Commission authorization to change residential electric rates effective January 1, 2010. The requested rate change is permitted by newly enacted Public Utilities Code Section 739.9, which allows the Commission to approve increases in rates for residential Tiers 1 and 2 (low monthly usage) in accordance with specific formulas. Specifically, SCE proposes to increase Tier 1 and Tier 2 rates on rate Schedule D by 5.0 percent and to decrease Tier 3, 4, and 5 rates in proportion to the increased revenues recovered from Tier 1 and Tier 2 residential customers. **SCE proposes no change in Tier 1 and Tier 2 rates for customers in the California Alternate Rates for Energy (CARE) program.** SCE's request in this Application will not change SCE's authorized revenues. To implement this rate change on January 1, 2010, SCE has requested in this application filing an expedited procedural schedule.



If the Commission approves the Application, charges for bundled service (customers who receive electric generation in addition to transmission and distribution services from SCE) residential customers will change. A customer with consumption roughly equal to the baseline allowance of 300 kWh will see a bill increase of less than \$2.00, or 4.9 percent. **A typical customer using 600 kWh (or about two times its baseline allowance) will see virtually no change in his or her bill while a higher usage residential customer using five times the baseline allowance (or 1,500 kWh) will see a decrease of about \$10.00, or 2.8 percent.** Individual bills may differ.

THE CPUC PROCESS

The CPUC's Division of Ratepayer Advocates (DRA) will review this Application. DRA is an independent arm of the CPUC, created by the Legislature to represent the interests of all utility customers throughout the state and obtain the lowest possible rate for service consistent with reliable and safe service levels. DRA has a multi-disciplinary staff with expertise in economics, finance, accounting and engineering. DRA's views do not necessarily reflect those of the CPUC. Other parties of record will also participate.

The CPUC may hold evidentiary hearings where parties of record present their proposals in testimony and are subject to cross-examination before an Administrative Law Judge (ALJ). These hearings are open to the public, but only those who are parties of record can present evidence or cross-examine witnesses during evidentiary hearings. Members of the public may attend these hearings, but are not allowed to participate, only listen.

After considering all proposals and evidence presented during the hearing process, the ALJ will issue a draft decision. When the CPUC acts on this application, it may adopt all or part of SCE's request, amend or modify it or deny the application. The CPUC's final decision may be different from SCE's request.
