**MOTION OF THE LATINO BUSINESS CHAMBER OF GREATER LOS ANGELES
REQUESTING LEAVE TO LATE FILE NOTICE OF INTENT TO CLAIM
INTERVENOR COMPENSATION**

Pursuant to Rule 11.1 of the California Public Utilities Commission ("CPUC") Rules of Practice and Procedure, the Latino Business Chamber of Greater Los Angeles ("LBCGLA") hereby requests Leave to Late File Notice of Intent to Claim Intervenor Compensation.

The LBCGLA seeks to intervene in Phase II because it addresses the definition of basic phone service and the types of services (such as pre-paid wireless options) the LifeLine program should encompass and incorporate. A very high percentage of the 500,000 Latino-owned businesses the LBCGLA directly or indirectly serves operate from their homes and are dependent, particularly during these difficult economic times, on subsidized LifeLine rates. Their productivity is greatly reduced since they do not have access to the relevant wireless telecommunications technology that is so basic to efficient connectivity.

The goal of the LBCGLA is to ensure that the 30% or more of our state's 15 million Latinos who are at 150% or below the poverty line have an opportunity to make a well-reasoned choice between wireless and landline choices. Those choices will be determined by the discussion in Phase II of these proceedings.

The LBCGLA plans to closely coordinate our efforts with the National Asian American Coalition and the Black Economic Council since they have many similar interests on behalf of their constituencies.
