TO INCREASE COMMENT PAGE LIMIT**

PIPELINE COMPANY LLC FOR
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In accordance with Rule 11.1 of the Commission’s Rules of Practice and Procedure, San Pablo Bay Pipeline Company, LLC (“San Pablo Bay”) applicant and defendant in the subject, consolidated proceedings, respectfully requests that the page limit on comments on the proposed decision (PD) of Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Karl Bemederfer issued in the above-referenced proceedings on March 9, 2011 be extended from the currently applicable 15-page limit to 25 pages.

In support of its motion, San Pablo Bay notes that the subject PD encompasses multiple proceedings extending over multiple years and involves important California pipeline infrastructure. Furthermore, it deals with complicated and controversial ratemaking issues, involving millions of dollars in refunds. The PD issued in these proceedings on March 9, 2011 addresses and resolves matters of extraordinary significance to San Pablo Bay. San Pablo Bay asks that it be afforded a full and fair opportunity to comprehensively comment on the myriad

legal, technical, factual, and policy issues presented by the PD. In this context, San Pablo Bay does not believe that it can be reasonably argued that any party's legitimate interest, including the interests of San Pablo Bay's shippers, will be disadvantaged by granting San Pablo Bay's request to extend the page limit on comments from 15 to 25 comment due date and the applicable page limit.

For all of these reasons, San Pablo Bay respectfully requests that the presently applicable 15-page limit on comments on the PD be extended to 25 pages. Attachment A hereto is a proposed form of order.
