**MOTION FOR PARTY STATUS FOR  
THE DIVISION OF RATEPAYER ADVOCATES**

Pursuant to Rule 1.4(a)(4) of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, the Division of Ratepayer Advocates ("DRA") respectfully submits this Motion for Party Status in the following case:

- Complaint of Rio Bravo Rocklin v. Pacific Gas and Electric Company (U39E) (C.10-07-020).

DRA is a ratepayer advocacy organization established under Section 309.5 of the California Public Utilities Code to represent and advocate on behalf of the interests of public utility customers and subscribers within the jurisdiction of the Commission. The goal of DRA is to "obtain the lowest possible rate for service consistent with reliable and safe service levels."<sup>1</sup>

Because the proposed settlement agreement in this proceeding may result in recovery of the settlement costs through the Energy Resource Recovery Account (ERRA), DRA has a statutory obligation to review the costs. DRA believes it will not prejudice any party, delay the schedule or broaden the scope of the proceeding. For the reasons stated above, DRA respectfully requests the Commission grant this Motion for Party Status.
