MOTION OF COX CALIFORNIA TELCOM, LLC FOR RULING SHORTENING TIME FOR RESPONSES TO APPLICATION

Pursuant to California Public Utilities Commission Rules of Practice and Procedure (“Rules”), Rules 11.1 and 2.6, Cox California Telcom, LLC (U-5684-C) (hereafter “Cox”) respectfully moves the Commission for a ruling shortening the time period for responding to the above-captioned Application. Concurrently with this Motion, Cox is also filing a separate motion in which it request the Commission shorten the time frame to respond to this motion.

In the Application, Cox requests permission to discontinue telecommunications services it is currently providing to a limited number of customers residing at locations where Cox will no longer have access to network facilities that it currently utilizes to serve such customers (“Buildings”). For clarity, Cox is not permanently discontinuing or withdrawing any services that it makes generally available and this Application is specific to customers residing at certain multi-tenant residential buildings.

Cox serves customers residing in the Buildings, in part, through facilities that Cox leases from CoxCom, LLC (“CoxCom”). Cox is requesting that the Commission expeditiously approve the Application due to the limited, prior notice that the building owner provided to CoxCom with respect to its access to the Buildings and that CoxCom and Cox thereafter had to respond to the notices. As explained in the Application, Cox will not have access to facilities necessary for it to provide service after October 31, 2011.

Cox understands that at least one other carrier is and will continue to serve residents at the Buildings and that Cox customers have been begun to transition off of Cox's service. Cox will do its best to continue to provide service until all of its current customers transition to new provider or the Commission grants the Application but Cox does not have control over a building owner granting requests for access to the Building Distribution Network after October 31, 2011.

Cox understands that there are a limited number of wireline carriers that actually provide residential service in the area where the Buildings are located. Nonetheless, Cox is serving a copy of this Motion and the Application via email (if available and via US Mail if otherwise) on a list of carriers obtained from the Commission's website to ensure they have notice of the Application and the request for a shortened time period to respond. Specifically, the service list includes carriers that provide "Local Residential Voice Services" in San Diego County.¹

For all the reasons stated herein, Cox respectfully requests that the Commission require responses to the Application be submitted by October 7, 2011² and replies be submitted by October 11, 2011. In its Application, Cox has already requested a waiver of the notice and comment period if there are no protests and the Commission grants its requested relief.
