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**NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY OF SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON (U 338-E) LOAD
IMPACT REPORTS REFLECTING DRAFT *EX ANTE* FORECASTS**

Pursuant to Rule 1.9 of the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) Rules of Practice and Procedure, as well as Commission Decisions (D.)08-04-050 and D.10-04-006, Southern California Edison Company (SCE) hereby provides notice to the service lists in proceedings R.07-01-041 and A.11-03-001, et.al., that the load impact reports reflecting draft *ex ante* load impact forecasts for program year 2011 are posted on SCE’s website on Wednesday, May 23, 2012. These load impact reports are available for review and comment by parties in accordance with Load Impact Protocol 27 adopted in D.08-04-050.¹ This report also includes SCE’s local *ex post* load impact forecasts in final form, previously made available to these service lists.

SCE posted its final *ex post* load impact reports on its website on April 2, 2012. However, as of that date, the Commission had not reached a final decision on the investor-owned utilities’ (IOUs’) 2012-2014 Demand Response (DR) applications, and it was not possible for SCE to post *ex ante* forecasts at that time. Based on the extension granted by the Executive Director of the Energy Division,² SCE hereby provides its load impact reports, which include SCE’s final local *ex post* and draft *ex ante*

load impact forecasts for program year 2011. On June 1, 2012, SCE will post its load impact reports reflecting final *ex ante* forecasts, including an Executive Summary.

In addition to the SCE-specific DR programs indicated below, SCE has DR programs that are included in the draft reports for the statewide DR programs, notice of which will be filed and served by San Diego Gas & Electric Company (SDG&E).

SCE provides notice that SCE's local *ex post* and draft *ex ante* load impact forecasts for program year 2011, along with draft summary tables for each of the following SCE-specific DR programs, have been posted on SCE's website:

- 1) Residential Summer Discount Plan;
- 2) Commercial Summer Discount Plan;
- 3) Real-Time Pricing Program; and
- 4) Agriculture and Pumping Interruptible Program.

The draft Reports and summary tables may be accessed on SCE's website as follows:
