**RESPONSE OF CRICKET COMMUNICATIONS, INC. (U-3076-C)  
TO APPLICATIONS FOR REHEARING OF DECISION 10-11-033 FILED BY TURN  
AND THE SMALL LECS**

Pursuant to Rule 16.1(d) of the California Public Utilities Commission ("Commission") Rules of Practice and Procedure, Cricket Communications (U-3076-C) ("Cricket") respectfully submits this response to the Applications for Rehearing filed by both The Utility Reform Network ("TURN") and the Small LECs<sup>1</sup> on the Commission's Decision D.10-11-033 in this docket.

**I. DISCUSSION**

Both TURN and the Small LECs seek rehearing on aspects of the Commission's LifeLine decision D.10-11-033 ("Decision") relating to conclusions regarding wireless carriers. Specifically, TURN argues, among other things, that the Decision incorrectly interprets D.00-10-028 to support its conclusion that wireless carriers may participate in the LifeLine program. The Small LECs, on the other hand, do not seek to overturn the Decision's conclusions regarding wireless participation in LifeLine, but seek removal of the following statements in the Decision:

(i) there is a "significant wireless carrier overlap with many of the rate-of-return carriers," and

(ii) “rate-of-return carriers’ overall financial results will not differ if wireless carriers receive LifeLine support for customers living in the rate-of-return carriers’ service territory.”<sup>2</sup> The Commission should reject TURN’s and the Small LECs’ arguments on these issues as meritless and deny these rehearing applications.

Contrary to TURN’s assertions, the Commission did, in fact, note in D.00-10-028 that wireless carriers should be able to participate in the state LifeLine program if certain conditions are met. Specifically, the Commission presented its proposal in D.00-10-028 that “CMRS carriers should be allowed to provide ULTS if they comply with all ULTS program rules.”<sup>3</sup> Accordingly, TURN is simply wrong that the Decision departs from D.00-10-028 and establishes a new “policy” that wireless carriers should be allowed to offer LifeLine. Moreover, to the extent that TURN asserts that there are issues that need to be resolved before wireless carriers can participate, the Decision expressly states that it “will have a Phase II in *this proceeding* to consider issues regarding implementation of LifeLine for wireless and other nontraditional carriers to offer guidance for their participation in the LifeLine Program.”<sup>4</sup>

The Commission should also reject the Small LECs’ request that it remove two sentences in the Decision regarding wireless carriers’ coverage and the impact of wireless participation on rate-of-return carriers’ financial results. The argument that the Small LECs offer for reversal is that Cricket’s coverage maps do not show significant overlap with the Small LEC territories. There are two key problems with this argument: (i) Cricket’s coverage maps do in fact show

substantial overlap with at least some of the Small LEC territories; and (ii) Cricket is not the only wireless carrier in the State.

Moreover, to the extent that the Small LECs take issue with the statement, they appear to believe that the sentence is critical to the Commission's conclusion that wireless carriers should be able to offer LifeLine in the Small LEC territories.<sup>5</sup> However, the Commission also stated that, in conjunction with the observation that there is wireless coverage overlap, "we can foresee no circumstance under which our universal service goals or objectives would be furthered by eliminating the ability of some consumers to choose alternative LifeLine providers."<sup>6</sup> Thus, the relevant point is not whether there is currently substantial overlap in the Small LEC territories. The relevant point is that, as a practical and legal matter, a wireless carrier with an FCC license cannot be restricted from providing service in its licensed areas – *including the Small LEC territories* – and that the Commission clearly promotes its universal service goals by allowing consumers in Small LEC territories to have access to a wireless LifeLine offering. Thus, the Commission correctly concluded that there is no policy basis for prohibiting wireless carriers from offering its low-income customers a discounted LifeLine option.

The Commission should similarly reject the Small LECs' arguments regarding the impact on their rates-of-return and financial results if wireless carriers offer LifeLine to their customers. Although the Small LECs argued previously in their comments on the draft decision that they will be unable to make up "unregulated" revenues from their customers who may migrate to
