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
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DIVISION OF RATEPAYER ADVOCATES' JANUARY 31, 2011 MOTION TO
COMPEL AND FEBRUARY 1, 2011 MOTION TO EXTEND SUBMISSION**

As directed by Administrative Law Judge Rochester by email on February 7, 2011, California-American Water Company hereby files its response to the January 31, 2011 Motion to Compel ("Motion to Compel") and February 1, 2011 Motion to Extend Submission ("Motion to Extend") of the Division of Ratepayer Advocates ("DRA").

After lengthy discussions, California American Water and DRA were able to reach a compromise on the disputed issues that DRA raised in the Motion to Compel. While not conceding any issues, DRA and California American Water agree that that is not necessary for the Administrative Law Judge to issue a ruling on those issues. California American Water and DRA were also able to reach agreement on the procedural schedule. Attached as Appendix A to this response is a table showing the current schedule, the schedule that DRA proposed in its motion, and the compromise proposed schedule agreed to by California American Water and DRA.
