**ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S
RULING SETTING A PREHEARING CONFERENCE**

On October 14, 2009, Redwood Resources Marketing, LLC (Redwood) filed the above-captioned complaint against Pacific Gas and Electric. This ruling sets a prehearing conference (PHC) for Monday, December 7, 2009, commencing at 10 a.m., located at the Commission's Courtroom, State Office Building, 505 Van Ness Avenue, San Francisco, California.

The parties shall be prepared to discuss the following at the PHC:

1. Identification of the specific factual and legal issues that the Commission needs to decide in this case;
2. Whether mediation conducted by an Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) from the Commission, other than the assigned ALJ, would be helpful in resolving the disputed issues;
3. Whether any discovery is needed;
4. The proposed schedule shown below; and
5. Other issues that the parties wish to raise at the PHC.
