**ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING RESETTING FILING DATES AND CLARIFYING APPLICABILITY OF PROPOSED CALIFORNIA TELEPHONE CORPORATION BILLING RULES**

On February 12, 2010, the assigned Commissioner issued his Ruling Requesting Comment on Proposed California Telephone Corporation Billing Rules. Since issuance of the ruling, parties have submitted two requests: CTIA - The Wireless Association moved for an extension of the filing dates for comments and reply comments, and clarification has been sought<sup>1</sup> regarding whether the billing rules apply only to third-party billing services.

CTIA - The Wireless Association motion requested an approximately four-week extension of the filing dates. Pursuant to Rule 11.1(g) of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, this request is granted, in part. Comments and reply comments must be filed and served as follows:

Reply Comments, filed and served	April 9, 2010

The request for clarification stated that the proposed rules appeared to apply only to billing for third-party goods or services, and not a carrier's own services, offered on a wholesale basis or directly to end-users.

The proposed Revised General Order 168, Part 4, billing rules are intended to apply both to third-party billing and a carrier's own billings. To the extent the proposed rules are not clear on this point, parties should submit comments and recommended modifications.
