ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING REQUIRING APPLICANT TO FILE A RESPONSE TO REQUEST FOR INFORMATION WITHIN 10 DAYS

On June 22, 2010, Wholesale Carrier Services, Inc. (Wholesale) filed this application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN) to provide resold and limited facilities-based local exchange telecommunications services within California.
