**ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING EXTENDING TIME FOR  
COMMENTS AND REPLY COMMENTS**

The proposed decision (PD), Decision Modifying Decision 10-03-021 Authorizing Use of Renewable Energy Credits for Compliance with the California Renewables Portfolio Standard and Lifting Stay and Moratorium Imposed by Decision 10-05-018, was mailed for comment on August 25, 2010. In accordance with Rule 14.3 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, comments would be due on September 15, 2010 and reply comments would be due on September 20, 2010.

The PD will appear on the Commission's agenda no earlier than the Commission meeting of October 14, 2010. There are thus more than 30 days between the mailing date and the Commission's consideration of the PD. In view of this additional time, and the likelihood that parties will want to take account of intervening legislative and administrative developments in their comments, the time for comments and reply comments can and should be extended.
