**ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING  
AMENDING THE PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This ruling modifies the Phase II procedural schedule as requested informally by various parties by e-mail dated October 19, 2010.<sup>1</sup> The adopted modification defers the scheduled dates for rebuttal testimony and hearings for marginal cost, revenue allocation and non-residential rate design, while keeping the existing October 29, 2010 rebuttal date and November hearings for residential rate design issues. As noted by the requesting parties, this adjustment will allow residential rate design issues to be decided as expeditiously as possible before

next summer. It also provides time for the parties to explore settlement for marginal cost, revenue allocation and non-residential rate design issues.

**IT IS RULED** that the procedural schedule is adjusted as follows:

1. Rebuttal testimony on residential rate design issues only shall be due on October 29, 2010.
2. The previously scheduled hearing dates of November 12, 15, 18, 19, and 22, 2010 shall address only residential rate design issues.
3. The Case Management Statement due on November 8, 2010, shall cover only residential rate design issues.
4. Rebuttal on all other issues previously scheduled for October 29, 2010 shall be due on December 17, 2010.
5. Hearings on all other issues shall be scheduled in a subsequent ruling, to be held no sooner than January 17, 2011.
