ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING IDENTIFYING, MARKING AND ADMITTING INTO THE RECORD ADDITIONAL EXHIBITS

1. Background

The second amended scoping memo and ruling of assigned Commissioner and Administrative Law Judge (ALJ), issued on July 13, 2010 (Second Amended Scoping Memo), among other things, identified the scope of issues to be considered in supplemental hearings, and amended the schedule for this proceeding established by the July 25, 2008 scoping memo and ruling of assigned Commissioner and ALJ, as amended by the January 21, 2010 amended scoping memo and ruling of assigned Commissioner and ALJ.

Pursuant to the Second Amended Scoping Memo, on July 23, 2010, Sacramento Natural Gas Storage, LLC (SNGS) served the supplemental direct testimony of Jim Fossum, William Fossum, Eric F. Hadsell, Nicole M. Houston, and Donald B. Russell. No party served rebuttal testimony. On August 12, 2010, via electronic mail, SNGS informed the ALJ that the no party intends to cross examine any of the witnesses who provided supplemental direct testimony on behalf of SNGS.

The September 10, 2010 ALJ ruling (September 10 Ruling) determined that evidentiary hearings are not needed to address the feasibility of the environmentally superior alternatives identified in the final environmental

impact report prepared in connection with Application 07-04-013. As a result, the September 10 Ruling, among other things, directed SNGS to serve a sworn declaration by each witness who provided supplemental direct testimony to affirm the submitted testimony.

**2. Identifying, Marking and Admitting into the Record
Additional Exhibits**

The September 10 Ruling provided that service of a sworn declaration by a witness who provided supplemental direct testimony would be treated as SNGS' request to move the item into the record, and provided guidance to parties wishing to object to the admission of any of SNGS' supplemental direct testimony. The September 10 Ruling provided that, subject to any objections to the admission of any of SNGS' supplemental direct testimony, a subsequent ruling would be issued to mark, identify, and admit SNGS' supplemental direct testimony into the record or to address any objections to the admission of any of SNGS' supplemental direct testimony.

On September 14, 2010, SNGS served on the service list for this proceeding and on the ALJ the sworn declarations of Jim Fossum, William Fossum, Eric F. Hadsell, Nicole M. Houston, and Donald B. Russell affirming their respective supplemental direct testimonies that were served on July 23, 2010. Pursuant to the September 10 Ruling, the service of these declarations is SNGS' request to move each of the items into the record.
