**ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING
ON MOTIONS FOR CONFIDENTIALITY**

This ruling addresses several outstanding motions for confidential treatment of filings in the above-captioned proceeding.

On June 18, 2010, Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E), the Division of Ratepayer Advocates (DRA), and The Utility Reform Network (TURN) filed individual motions seeking an order granting leave to file confidential versions of their opening briefs under seal. On July 2, 2010, PG&E, DRA, and TURN also filed individual motions seeking an order granting leave to file confidential versions of their reply opening briefs under seal.
