**ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING  
CONFIRMING ELECTRONIC MAIL RULING  
DIRECTING PARTIES TO PROVIDE INFORMATION**

**Summary**

The electronic mail (email) ruling of September 15, 2011 (September 15 Email Ruling) advised parties that another prehearing conference (PHC) will be scheduled in San Francisco, and directed parties to provide information. This ruling confirms the September 15 Email Ruling.

**Background**

A PHC in this matter was scheduled for August 19, 2011. Parties were served notice via United States (U.S.) Mail and via email on August 9, 2011, pursuant to Rules 1.9, 1.10, and 13.1(a) of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure. In addition, the PHC was noticed in the Commission's Daily Calendar, pursuant to Rule 1.17. Mr. Wolk failed to appear at the PHC.

I subsequently received Mr. Wolk's August 25, 2011 letter asserting that he did not receive notice of the PHC at a location where he could receive it (August 25 Letter). The August 25 Letter requests that another PHC be scheduled in Los Angeles or San Diego, or that Mr. Wolk be allowed to participate in the PHC via telephone. A copy of the August 25 Letter is attached to this ruling.

### **Discussion**

The service list for this proceeding contains the email address "arthurwolk@airlaw.com" for Mr. Wolk. Pursuant to Rule 1.10(a), Mr. Wolk has consented to email service of documents in the proceeding by providing an email address for the official service list in the proceeding.

Mr. Wolk is directed to confirm that the email address "[arthurwolk@airlaw.com](mailto:arthurwolk@airlaw.com)" is correct and that he is able to receive email messages sent to this email address. Mr. Wolk must confirm his email address via reply to the September 15 Email Ruling not later than 5:00 pm (Pacific Daylight Time (PDT), Wednesday, September 21, 2011.

The service list for this proceeding lists "1678 Marisma Way, La Jolla, CA 92037" as Complainant's address, and this is the same address shown in the complaint. However, the August 25 Letter shows a return address of 1710-12 Locust Street, Philadelphia, PA 19103.

Mr. Wolk is directed, not later than 5:00 pm (PDT), Wednesday, September 21, 2011, to provide me the address at which he wishes to receive service via U.S. Mail. The Commission's Process Office will update the service list to show the address provided in response to this ruling as the Complainant's address for service via U.S. Mail of all documents.

As stated above, another PHC will be scheduled to be held in San Francisco. Parties will be permitted to participate in the PHC via telephone, if they so choose. A court reporter will transcribe the PHC.

Parties are directed to confirm, not later than 5:00 pm (PDT), Wednesday, September 21, 2011, the dates on which they are available to participate in a PHC, and whether they wish to participate on those dates in person or via telephone. A subsequent ruling will be issued scheduling the PHC.
