**ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING GRANTING MOTION
TO LATE FILE NOTICE OF COMPLIANCE**

On September 7, 2011, pursuant to Rule 3.2(e), Golden State Water Company (Golden State) filed its notice of compliance with Rule 3.2 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedures (Rules). On September 20, 2011, Golden State's notice of compliance was rejected by the Commission's Docket Office (Docket Office) because it did not provide proof of compliance with Rule 3.2(b).¹

On September 22, 2011, I directed Golden State to promptly comply with the Rule 3.2(b),² and to request an extension of time to late-file its notice of
