**ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING
GRANTING MOTION FOR PARTY STATUS
FILED BY BUILD IT GREEN**

By motion filed on December 14, 2011, Build It Green (BIG) requests that it be given party status in this proceeding. For the reasons set forth below, this ruling grants BIG's request for party status.

BIG states that it is a membership-supported 501(c)(3) non-profit corporation that promotes healthy, energy and resource efficient homes in California. BIG claims to have played an instrumental role in the design and implementation of Energy Upgrade California, to have been an active participant in Public Goods Charge funded programs, and to have worked closely with all of California's investor-owned utilities on green building issues.

BIG asserts that its interests are not represented by any party in this proceeding and that it will participate by providing comments that are directly relevant to the issues presented.
