**ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING  
REQUESTING INFORMATION**

In their complaint, Skip and Gail Thomson (Complainants) state:

“(1) The local loop demarcation point is located on a temporary, freestanding wooden post. (6” x 6” redwood post). Pac Bell is dictating where the loop can be permanently attached. Pac Bell states only on the garage of the main residence. We want to permanently attach the loop to the newly constructed detached garage. The newly constructed detached garage is located in the Vacaville exchange. The main residence is in the Dixon exchange. (2) Adrian Tyler has denied us legal phone service to the residential structure we recently received a building permit for. See attached. Address of 5750 Weber Rd Vacaville, CA 95687.” (See Complaint – Section (F.1) 2.)

Complainants shall provide information as follows:

1. Confirm that the redwood post (referred to above) is located in the Dixon exchange.

2. Confirm that the main residence and its attached garage are located in the Dixon exchange.
3. Provide a copy of the building permit for the new construction.
4. State the completion date and provide a copy of the plan submitted for the permit for the new construction.

**IT IS RULED** that:

1. Complainant shall mail the above information to me by Friday, May 9, 2003. A copy shall be mailed to Michael D. Sasser, Attorney for Pacific Bell Telephone Company, 140 New Montgomery Street, 16<sup>th</sup> Floor, San Francisco, CA 94105.
2. There being no material facts in dispute, there is no need for an evidentiary hearing and this case shall be submitted for decision upon receipt of the above information.
