PUC AND CEC TO HOLD JOINT MEETING ON CONTINUED IMPLEMENTATION OF STATE'S ENERGY ACTION PLAN

SAN FRANCISCO, May 26, 2005 - The California Public Utilities Commission (PUC) today announced it will host a joint meeting with the California Energy Commission (CEC) regarding the continued implementation of the state's Energy Action Plan on June 15, 2005, from 1:30 p.m. to 5 p.m. in the PUC's Auditorium at 505 Van Ness Ave., San Francisco.

Topics of discussion will include:

- Continued implementation of the 2003 Energy Action Plan;
- Discuss, review, and seek comment on a new 2005 Energy Action Plan;
- Review the electric supply/demand outlook for the summer 2005; and,
- Discuss other current energy events and topics of joint interest.

A final agenda for the meeting will be available on both the PUC and CEC websites.
