SUBJECT: Order authorizing Southern California Water Company to carry out the terms and conditions of two agreements, one with Frank Fallone and one with Hunt Enterprises Incorporated.

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA WATER COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 440-W, filed May 30, 1974, requests authority under Section 532 of the Public Utilities Code and Section X-A of General Order No. 96-A, to carry out the terms and conditions of an agreement with Frank Fallone for the installation of fire protection facilities at the cost of \$9,134.17 and an agreement with Hunt Enterprises Incorporated for the installation of fire protection facilities estimated at \$7,475, and

WHEREAS: Southern California Water Company requests authority to deviate from the filed main extension rule, to allow the utility, to make advances for fire protection facilities subject to refund, and

THE COMMISSION FINDS that the terms and conditions of the agreements will not be adverse to the public interests and are justified,

IT IS ORDERED that Southern California Water Company is authorized to carry out the terms and conditions of the agreements referred to above and filed with Advice Letter No. 440-W.
