SUBJECT: Order authorizing Highway City Water Company to revise and modify certain of its present rules governing water service.

WHEREAS: HIGHWAY CITY WATER COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 10 filed October 21, 1974, requests authority to change certain of its rules governing water service which will result in technical increases in Rule No. 7, Deposits, and in Rule No. 11, Discontinuance and Restoration of Service, and

WHEREAS: These changes consist of changing the required deposit to establish credit for 5/8 x 3/4-inch meters from \$5 for monthly bills and for all other services to twice the estimated average monthly bill, whether billed monthly or bi-monthly. Flat rate service customers will be required to deposit one month's minimum charge. The revision increases the reconnection charge during regular working hours from \$2.50 to \$5 for other than regular working hours from \$5 to \$15.

THE COMMISSION FINDS that these changes in the rules are justified and reasonable.

IT IS ORDERED that Highway City Water Company be authorized to make the necessary changes in its filed rules as transmitted with Advice Letter No. 10.
