SUBJECT: Order authorizing California-American Water Company to increase rates for water service in the Duarte District, Los Angeles County, to offset increases in charges for electric power.

WHEREAS: CALIFORNIA-AMERICAN WATER COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 114, filed September 10, 1974, requests authority under General Order No. 96-A, Section VI, and Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code to increase rates for water service in its Duarte District, Los Angeles County, and

WHEREAS: The Commission is of the opinion, after investigation by its staff, that the requested rate increase is reasonable,

THE COMMISSION FINDS that the increased rates hereby authorized are justified and that the present rates are, for the future, unjust and unreasonable,

IT IS ORDERED that California-American Water Company is authorized to make effective the revised rate schedules attached to Advice Letter No. 114 and on the effective date herein to cancel the presently effective rate schedules for water service. The effective date of the revised rate schedules shall be September 29, 1974.
