**SUBJECT:** Order authorizing California Water Service Company to increase rates for water service in the Palos Verdes District, Los Angeles County, to offset increases in charges for electric power, purchased water, and wages and salaries.

**WHEREAS:** CALIFORNIA WATER SERVICE COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 451 filed June 18, 1975, requests authority under General Order No. 96-A, Section VI, and Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code to increase rates for water service in its Palos Verdes District, Los Angeles County, and

**WHEREAS:** The Commission is of the opinion, after investigation by its staff, that the requested rate increase is reasonable.

**THE COMMISSION FINDS** that the increased rates hereby authorized are justified and that the present rates are, for the future, unjust and unreasonable.

**IT IS ORDERED** that California Water Service Company is authorized to make effective the revised Rate Schedule No. PV-1 attached to Advice Letter No. 451 and on the effective date herein to cancel the presently effective rate schedule for water service. The effective date of the revised rate schedule shall be July 13, 1975.
