**SUBJECT:** Order authorizing California Water Service Company to delete a portion of its South San Francisco District service area, San Mateo County.

**WHEREAS:** CALIFORNIA WATER SERVICE COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 455, received June 23, 1975, requests authority under Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code and Section XIV of General Order No. 96-A, to revise the service area map of its South San Francisco District to conform with the agreement with the city and county of San Francisco approved by this Commission on September 22, 1961, and

**WHEREAS:** The adjustments are small and are not reflected on the small scale of the map, and

**WHEREAS:** There is no withdrawal of service from any area as a result of the adjustments in the border and no customer of the utility is affected.

**THE COMMISSION FINDS** that the proposed revisions in the service area of the South San Francisco District of California Water Service Company is reasonable and justified.

**IT IS ORDERED** that California Water Service Company is authorized to make the necessary changes in its filed tariffs as transmitted with Advice Letter No. 455.
