SUBJECT: Order authorizing Southern California Water Company to enter into an agreement with the Mojave Water Agency to deviate from Rule 15, Main Extensions, to serve a potential 61 individuals near Barstow, San Bernardino County.

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA WATER COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 473-W, received December 10, 1975, requests authority under Section 532 of the Public Utilities Code to deviate from the main extension rule allowing it to install at its own expense 3,050 feet of mains rather than the allowed 50 feet, under the present rule, and

WHEREAS: The estimated cost to the utility for the 3,050 feet of mains is \$39,000, and the estimated cost to be advanced by the agency for 14,031 feet of 6- and 8-inch mains is \$153,000, and

THE COMMISSION FINDS that the deviation will be beneficial to the potential 61 customers and will not be adverse to the public interest and is justified,

IT IS ORDERED that Southern California Water Company is authorized to deviate from its filed main extension rule as referred to above and as filed with Advice Letter No. 473-W.
