R E S O L U T I O N

SUBJECT: Order authorizing Farmers Irrigation Company to increase rates for measured irrigation service in Ventura County.

WHEREAS: Farmers Irrigation Company, by Advice Letter No. 6, filed December 1, 1975 requests authority under General Order No. 96-A, Section VI, and Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code to increase rates for measured irrigation service in Ventura County, and

WHEREAS: The Commission is of the opinion, after investigation by its staff, that the requested rate increase is reasonable.

THE COMMISSION FINDS that the increased rates hereby authorized are justified and that the present rates are, for the future, unjust and unreasonable.

IT IS ORDERED that Farmers Irrigation Company is authorized to make effective the revised rate schedule attached to Advice Letter No. 6 and on the effective date herein to cancel the presently effective rate schedule for measured irrigation service. The effective date of the revised rate schedule shall be January 1, 1976.
