R E S O L U T I O N

SUBJECT: Order authorizing Wesmilton Water System to increase rates for water service in Fresno County.

WHEREAS: WESMILTON WATER SYSTEM by Advice Letter No. 16, filed October 9, 1975, requests authority under General Order No. 96-A, Section VI, and Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code to increase rates for water service in Fresno County, and

WHEREAS: The Commission is of the opinion, after investigation by its staff, that the requested rate increase is reasonable,

THE COMMISSION FINDS that the increased rates hereby authorized are justified and that the present rates are, for the future, unjust and unreasonable,

IT IS ORDERED that Wesmilton Water System, is authorized to make effective the revised rate schedules attached to Advice Letter No. 16 and on the effective date herein to cancel the presently effective rate schedules for water service. The effective date of the revised rate schedules shall be December 1, 1975.
