SUBJECT: Order authorizing Southern California Water Company to increase rates for water service in the Orange County District, Orange County, to offset increases in charges for electric power.

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA WATER COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 429-W, filed February 21, 1974, requests authority under General Order No. 96-A, Section VI, and Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code to increase rates for water service in its Orange County District, Orange County, and

WHEREAS: The Commission is of the opinion, after investigation by its staff, that the requested rate increase is reasonable.

THE COMMISSION FINDS that the increased rates hereby authorized are justified and that the present rates are, for the future, unjust and unreasonable,

IT IS ORDERED that Southern California Water Company is authorized to make effective the revised rate schedules Nos. OC-1 and OC-3M attached to Advice Letter No. 429-W and on the effective date herein to cancel the presently effective rate schedule for water service. The effective date of the revised rate schedules shall be March 29, 1974.
