SUBJECT: Order authorizing Sierra Highlands Water Company to carry out the terms and conditions of Agreements with Boise Cascade Recreation Communities Corporation of Delaware and the Don Pedro Owner's Association to obtain water rights and to use water collection area and serve the golf course.

WHEREAS: SIERRA HIGHLANDS WATER COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 13 filed February 21, 1974 requests authority to obtain the water rights and use of a water collection area to serve the golf course, and

WHEREAS: Boise Cascade now owns the water rights and the collection area is owned by the Don Pedro Owner's Association, and

WHEREAS: The utility has now signed agreements with each organizations, and

WHEREAS: The utility will benefit by making available more water for use elsewhere on the system by substitution and therefore requests Commission approval.

THE COMMISSION FINDS that these agreements are reasonable and justified,

IT IS ORDERED that the agreements be authorized as requested by Sierra Highlands Water Company in Advice Letter No. 13.
