**SUBJECT:** Order authorizing California Cities Water Company to increase rates for water service in the Cowan Heights District, Orange County, to offset increases in charges for electric power and purchased water.

**WHEREAS:** CALIFORNIA CITIES WATER COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 23, filed April 29, 1974, requests authority under General Order No. 96-A, Section VI, and Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code to increase rates for water service in its Cowan Heights District, Orange County, and

**WHEREAS:** The Commission is of the opinion, after investigation by its staff, that the requested rate increase is reasonable,

**THE COMMISSION FINDS** that the increased rates hereby authorized are justified and that the present rates are, for the future, unjust and unreasonable,

**IT IS ORDERED** that California Cities Water Company is authorized to make effective the revised rate schedules attached to Advice Letter No. 23 and on the effective date herein to cancel the presently effective rate schedule for water service. The effective date of the revised rate schedules shall be May 12, 1974.
