RESOLUTION

SUBJECT: Order authorizing Tahoe Paradise Water and Gas Co. to deviate from the refund provisions of Rule No. 15, Main Extensions, in an agreement for a main extension with Lee F. Willis of Christmas Valley Condominiums.

WHEREAS: TAHOE PARADISE WATER AND GAS CO., by Advice Letter No. 36, received April 4, 1975, requests authority to deviate from the refund provisions of Rule No. 15, Main Extensions, by excluding the back-up facilities and inspection fee to serve the Christmas Valley Condominiums of Lee F. Willis, and

WHEREAS: The estimated cost of construction to serve 16 condominiums and 2 fire hydrants is \$37,442 of which \$35,550 is subject to refund in accordance with the provisions of Rule No. 15, Main Extensions; the balance, or \$1,872, shall be a contribution not subject to refund.

THE COMMISSION FINDS that the deviation from the refund provisions of Rule No. 15 will not be adverse to the public interest and is justified,

IT IS ORDERED that Tahoe Paradise Water and Gas Co. is authorized to deviate from Rule No. 15, Main Extensions, as requested in Advice Letter No. 36.
