SUBJECT: Order Authorizing California Water Service Company to Increase Rates for Water Service in the East Los Angeles District, Los Angeles County, to Offset Increases in Purchased Water.

WHEREAS: CALIFORNIA WATER SERVICE COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 485, filed May 5, 1976, requests authority under General Order No. 96-A, Section VI, and Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code to increase rates for water service in its East Los Angeles District, Los Angeles County, and

WHEREAS: The Commission is of the opinion, after investigation by its staff, that the requested rate increase is reasonable,

THE COMMISSION FINDS that the increased rates hereby authorized are justified and that the present rates are, for the future, unjust and unreasonable.

IT IS ORDERED that California Water Service Company is authorized to make effective the revised rate schedules attached to Advice Letter No. 485 and on the effective date herein to cancel the presently effective rate schedule for water service. The effective date of the revised rate schedules shall be July 1, 1976. The effective date of this resolution is the date hereof.
