RESOLUTION

SUBJECT: Order authorizing California Water Service Company to increase rates for water service in the Livermore District, Alameda County, to offset increases in wages, payroll taxes and income taxes.

WHEREAS: CALIFORNIA WATER SERVICE COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 491, filed June 3, 1976, requests authority under General Order No. 96-A, Section VI, and Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code, to increase rates for water service in its Livermore District, Alameda County, and

WHEREAS: The Commission is of the opinion, after investigation by its staff, that the requested rate increase is reasonable,

THE COMMISSION FINDS that the increased rates hereby authorized are justified and that the present rates are, for the future, unjust and unreasonable.

IT IS ORDERED that California Water Service Company is authorized to make effective the revised rate schedule attached to Advice Letter No. 491 and on the effective date herein to cancel the presently effective rate schedule for water service. The effective date of the revised rate schedule shall be July 12, 1976. The effective date of this resolution is the date hereof.
