SUBJECT: Order authorizing Dominguez Water Corporation to increase rates for water service in Los Angeles County, to offset increases in charges for purchased water, electric power and wages.

WHEREAS: DOMINGUEZ WATER CORPORATION, by Advice Letter No. 77, filed June 23, 1976, requests authority under General Order No. 96-A, Section VI, and Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code to increase rates for water service in Los Angeles County, and

WHEREAS: The Commission is of the opinion, after investigation by its staff, that the requested rate increase is reasonable,

THE COMMISSION FINDS that the increased rates hereby authorized are justified and that the present rates are, for the future, unjust and unreasonable,

IT IS ORDERED that Dominguez Water Corporation is authorized to make effective the revised rate schedules attached to Advice Letter No. 77 and on the effective date herein to cancel the presently effective rate schedules for water service. The effective date of the revised rate schedules shall be July 18, 1976. The effective date of this resolution is the date hereof.
