SUBJECT: Order Authorizing East Pasadena Water Company to Increase Rates for Water Service in Los Angeles County, to Offset Increase in Watermaster Assessments.

WHEREAS: EAST PASADENA WATER COMPANY by Advice Letter No. 18, filed June 30, 1976, requests authority under General Order No. 96-A, Section VI and Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code to increase rates for water service in Los Angeles County, and

WHEREAS: The Commission is of the opinion after investigation by its staff, that the requested rate increase is reasonable,

THE COMMISSION FINDS that the increased rates hereby authorized are justified and that the present rates are, for the future, unjust and unreasonable.

IT IS ORDERED that East Pasadena Water Company is authorized to make effective the revised rate schedule attached to Advice Letter No. 18 and on the effective date herein to cancel the presently effective rate schedule for water service. The effective date of the revised rate schedule shall be August 22, 1976. The effective date of this resolution is the date hereof.
