ORGANIZATION

Alliance For Human And Environmental Health (“AHEH”) is an Unincorporated Non-Profit Association registered with the California Secretary of State pursuant to California Corporations Code Section 21300.

PURPOSE

AHEH is a coalition of concerned citizens and organizations, dedicated to the promotion and support of America's environmentally safe, reliable, cost-efficient and secure energy production, supply and delivery systems, and the ongoing education, representation, and protection of California consumers who are customers of public utility energy providers. AHEH participates in California Public Utilities Commission regulatory proceedings and other related activities to further these goals.

OFFICERS

The chief officer of AHEH is the President, Barry A. Smith. The President is responsible for overall management of AHEH including development and implementation of policies, establishing officer positions and appointing officers, creating advisory or other committees to assist in the conduct of AHEH's affairs and appointing members thereof, administering the financial affairs of AHEH, developing membership requirements and accepting individuals or organizations as members, and such other actions as the President deems in the best interests of the Association.

MANAGEMENT AND IMPLEMENTATION OF AHEH'S PURPOSE

The Management Committee of AHEH consists of the President, Vice-President, and Secretary. The Management Committee shall have authority to act on such matters as the President shall designate. The President may delegate management and other responsibilities to the Management Committee and shall establish the procedures, such required quorum and votes, to be followed. The President may be a member of any such Committee, which shall include at least two other members.

MEMBERSHIP

Membership in AHEH is open to individuals and organizations that concur in and support the policies, actions and objectives of AHEH. The President shall establish the criteria applicable to membership including but not limited to dues or other affirmative contributions to the goals of AHEH, required participation in AHEH activities, and the like. The President may also establish classes of membership and their respective rights and obligations, and has the authority to terminate membership for any reason if such action serves the purposes of AHEH.
