CENTER FOR ELECTROSMOG PREVENTION’S RESPONSE TO MOTION OF COUNTY OF MARIN, TOWN OF FAIRFAX, CA, AND THE ALLIANCE FOR HUMAN AND ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH TO REQUIRE DELAY OF FURTHER SMARTMETER INSTALLATIONS UNTIL DETERMINATION OF COMMUNITY OPT-OUT RIGHTS IN PHASE 2

Pursuant to the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC or Commission)’s Rules of Practice and Procedure, Rule 11.1, the Center for Electrosmog Prevention (CEP) submits this response to the MOTION OF COUNTY OF MARIN, TOWN OF FAIRFAX, CA, AND THE ALLIANCE FOR HUMAN AND ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH TO REQUIRE DELAY OF

FURTHER SMARTMETER INSTALLATIONS UNTIL DETERMINATION OF
COMMUNITY OPT-OUT RIGHTS IN PHASE 2 (Motion).

CEP supports the Motion of County of Marin, Town of Fairfax, California, and The Alliance for Human and Environmental Health (“Joint Movants”) requesting an immediate Commission ruling directing Pacific Gas and Electric Company (“PG&E”) to temporarily suspend further deployments of SmartMeters in the jurisdictions identified until resolution of the community opt-out issues designated for Phase 2 of this proceeding.

Additionally, we fully support the Joint Movants' rationale for this Motion, and its requests of the Commission. We further move that all of their main points and requests, including suspension of further deployment, be extended to SCE and SDG&E as part of this consolidated proceeding.
