ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING REOPENING RECORD FOR THE LIMITED PURPOSE OF DIRECTING APPLICANTS TO SUBMIT INFORMATION REQUIRED UNDER RULE 16.4(b) OF THE COMMISSION'S RULES OF PRACTICE AND PROCEDURE

This ruling reopens the record in order for applicants California Water Service Company, Golden State Water Company, Park Water Company and Apple Valley Ranchos Water Company to submit specific wording to carry out all requested modifications to the underlying decisions requested herein.

Rule 16.4(b) of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure requires, in part:

A petition for modification of a Commission decision must concisely state the justification for the requested relief and must propose specific wording to carry out all requested modifications to the decision.

The underlying decisions at issue here are:

- Decision 08-02-036 for Cal-Water and Park;
- Decision 08-08-030 for Golden State Regions II and III;
- Decision 08-09-026 for Apple Valley;¹ and
- Decision 09-05-005 for Golden State Region I

Each applicant should submit specific wording for any requested changes to its decision(s) that include text within the decisions, Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Ordering Paragraphs. For Decision (D.) 08-02-036, D.08-08-030, and D.09-05-005, applicants should also attach the settlements adopted in each decision and cite to the specific wording changes.

IT IS RULED that:

1. The record in this proceeding is reopened for the limited purpose of having applicants submit the information requested above by Wednesday, February 8, 2012.
2. The Division of Ratepayer Advocates may submit comments on applicants' filings by February 13, 2012.
3. With receipt of the information above, this proceeding will be submitted.
