**ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING SETTING
SCHEDULE FOR POST-WORKSHOP COMMENTS**

This ruling sets a schedule for post-workshop comments and completed proposals regarding the design and implementation of an incentive mechanism applicable to energy efficiency resource programs for the 2013-2014 cycle. Parties have previously submitted preliminary incentive mechanism proposals for the 2013-2014 program in this proceeding, with varying degrees of detail. A workshop was convened on August 20, 2012, to provide a forum for discussion and information exchange among parties regarding energy efficiency incentive design issues for the 2013-2014 cycle. Since the conclusion of the workshop, parties have had the opportunity to continue informal discussions regarding the appropriate design and implementation of an incentive mechanism for the 2013-2014 cycle. Hopefully, this exchange of ideas and information among the parties will be useful in developing and finalizing proposals regarding how incentives should be designed and implemented for the 2013-2014 cycle.

Parties are directed to finalize any remaining aspects of their proposals and to present complete proposals for an incentive mechanism for energy efficiency resource programs for the 2013-2014 cycle. These finalized proposals

shall be due on October 1, 2012. To the extent that parties are able to reach agreement on how to design and implement an incentive mechanism, parties should coordinate to file and serve joint comments. To the extent that parties disagree on incentive issues, separate proposals on incentive design and implementation for 2013-2014 shall be filed and served.

IT IS RULED that post-workshop comments and proposals for the design and implementation of an incentive mechanism for energy efficiency resource programs for the 2013-2014 cycle shall be filed and served on October 1, 2012.
