**ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING GRANTING
MOTION TO SHORTEN TIME FOR RESPONDING
TO PETITION FOR MODIFICATION
OF DECISION 11-12-019**

On October 5, 2012, a petition was filed and served by San Diego Gas & Electric Company (SDG&E) seeking modification of Decision 11-12-019. SDG&E seeks authority to temporarily suspend collection of its otherwise required California Solar Initiative (CSI) revenue requirement, effective January 1, for the duration of the 2013 calendar year. SDG&E submits that suspension of the collection of this revenue requirement in the manner it proposes provides a rate decrease to electric ratepayers in 2013 and will, if allowed, have no impact on the incentive funds available to the CSI program in SDG&E territory. SDG&E simultaneously filed and served a motion to shorten time for responding to the petition, moving for a reduction from 30 days to 15 days.

No responses to the motion have been received. There is no known opposition to the motion.

IT IS RULED that the October 5, 2012, motion filed and served by San Diego Gas & Electric Company (SDG&E) is granted. As a result, responses to the petition for modification filed and served on October 5, 2012 by SDG&E seeking authority to temporarily suspend collection of its California Solar Initiative revenue requirement shall be filed and served by October 22, 2012
