**MOTION OF THE JOINT MINORITY PARTIES TO LATE FILE COMMENTS
ON ASSIGNED COMMISSIONER AND ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGES' RULING
REQUESTING SETTLING PARTIES TO ADOPT MODIFICATIONS TO PROPOSED
SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT**

Pursuant to Rule 11.1 of the Rules of Practice and Procedure of the California Public Utilities Commission ("CPUC" or "Commission"), the National Asian American Coalition, the Ecumenical Center for Black Church Studies, the Los Angeles Latino Chamber of Commerce, and the Chinese American Institute for Empowerment hereby make their motion to late file (by one day) Comments on the Assigned Commissioner and Administrative Law Judges' Ruling Requesting Settling Parties to Adopt Modifications to Proposed Settlement Agreement.

Although the above ruling was timely served, the newly assigned attorney to I.12-10-013, Cassandra Yamasaki, was out of the office celebrating her wedding/honeymoon at the time of service, and just returned today, on September 16, 2014. At the time of service, Ms. Yamasaki was without access to her work email or "back-up" staff (as the attorney formerly assigned to the

case was also abroad celebrating his wedding/honeymoon at the same time), and as a result, did not become aware of the above ruling until this morning.

Accordingly, the Joint Minority Parties respectfully request that the ALJs grant leave for the Joint Minority Parties to late file (by one day) their Comments on the Assigned Commissioner and Administrative Law Judges' Ruling Requesting Settling Parties to Adopt Modifications to Proposed Settlement Agreement.

No possible prejudice exists to the affected Utilities or the Commission since the Settling Parties have until September 19th to file their comments.
