**ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING ON PREHEARING CONFERENCE
PROCESS AND REQUESTING PREHEARING CONFERENCE STATEMENTS**

1. Prehearing Conference

A Prehearing Conference (PHC) in this matter will be held before
Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Anne Simon on September 18, 2015, at
10:00 a.m., in the Commission Courtroom, State Office Building,
505 Van Ness Avenue, San Francisco, California.

Parties desiring expedited transcripts should advise the Chief Hearing
Reporter via e-mail at reporting@cpuc.ca.gov, no later than three days prior to
the day of the PHC.

If you have questions about the PHC date, time, or place, call the
Commission's Calendar Clerk at (415) 703-1203.

The purpose of the PHC is to prepare for the evidentiary hearings
scheduled for October 5, 2015, and two succeeding days if necessary, as set forth
in the Administrative Law Judge's Ruling Setting Evidentiary Hearings and
Setting a Schedule for Further Activities Prior to Evidentiary Hearings
(September 2, 2015). The PHC will address issues necessary to prepare for the
evidentiary hearings, including but not limited to:

- order of witnesses;
- time limits for cross-examination;
- presentation of complex evidence (e.g., presentation of material generated from computer runs of models);
- management of exhibits; and
- exploration of parties with similar positions combining or delegating cross-examination responsibilities.

2. PHC Statements

PHC statements are not required. However, any party intending to sponsor testimony or to appear and cross-examine at the evidentiary hearing must file and serve a prehearing conference statement not later than September 16, 2015.

PHC statements should include:

1. Identification of all witnesses whose testimony the party will be sponsoring, with the topic of the testimony for each witness.
2. Identification (so far as can be known) of topics on which the party will be undertaking cross-examination;
3. Identification of any issues with respect to presentation of complex evidence that should be addressed at the PHC;
4. Any other issues that a party believes should be discussed at the PHC, within the scope of the PHC, i.e., preparing for the evidentiary hearings.

Parties are encouraged, but not required, to confer in advance of the PHC to discuss areas of potential coordination, including but not limited to filing joint PHC statements.

IT IS RULED that:

1. A Prehearing Conference will be held on September 18, 2015, at 10:00 a.m., in the Commission Courtroom, State Office Building, 505 Van Ness Avenue, San Francisco, California
2. Any party intending to sponsor testimony or appear and cross-examine at the hearing must, and other parties may, file and serve prehearing conference statements of not more than 20 pages, prepared in accordance with the guidelines in this ruling, not later than September 16, 2015.
3. Parties are encouraged to confer and cooperate in developing their proposals for management of the evidentiary hearing and in presenting prehearing conference statements.
