[PROPOSED] RULING GRANTING PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY'S MOTION TO COMPEL DISCOVERY FROM INTERVENOR THE CITY OF CARMEL-BY-THE-SEA

Having reviewed the Motion to Compel filed on behalf of Pacific Gas & Electric Company ("PG&E"), the opposition thereto filed by Intervenor Carmel-by-the-Sea ("Carmel"), the reply filed by PG&E, and any related documents or argument properly submitted by either party, the Honorable ALJ Maribeth A. Bushey rules as follows:

1. PG&E's Motion to Compel Carmel to provide responses to Questions 13 through 23 in PG&E's third sets of data requests is **GRANTED**. Carmel will provide PG&E with full and complete written answers and all responsive, non-privileged documents by January 15, 2016.

IN THE ALTERNATIVE

2. PG&E's motion to compel is **DENIED**. Carmel is precluded from submitting in this proceeding any facts or evidence on the subjects on which PG&E sought to compel discovery in this Motion.
