**ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE RULING SETTING APPEAL HEARING**

An Appeal Hearing is hereby scheduled in the above captioned matter to address the appeal of TeleDias Communications, Inc. (U6725C) from Citation No.189-587 issued on February 17, 2016.<sup>1</sup> The appeal will be heard on July 5, 2016 at 1:30 p.m. in the Commission Courtroom, State Office Building, 505 Van Ness Avenue, San Francisco, California.

The parties are directed to meet and confer to identify stipulated facts, if any, and the key issues to be considered. Parties are required to file a statement of stipulated facts by June 28, 2016. The joint statement of stipulated facts should also identify any factual issues in dispute. Additionally, parties must jointly submit a schedule for any witnesses to be presented at hearing and an estimate of time for each witness to the Assigned Administrative Law Judge by June 28, 2016.

At the hearing, parties must be fully prepared to present their case; including documentary evidence and witness testimony if necessary. Parties are advised to bring three copies of any document they intend to introduce into the

record during the hearing. If a party desires a transcript of the hearing, the party must make a request at the hearing.

While this appeal is pending, neither party shall engage in an *ex parte* communication<sup>2</sup> with a Commissioner, a Commissioner's advisor, or the Judge, except for procedural or scheduling purposes. Parties are advised to review the California Public Utilities Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure.

<sup>2</sup> Rule 8.1 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure states "*Ex parte* communication" means a written communication (including a communication by letter or electronic medium) or oral communication (including a communication by telephone or in person) that: 1) concerns any substantive issue in a formal proceeding, 2) takes place between an interested person and a decision-maker, and 3) does not occur in a public hearing, workshop, or other public forum noticed by ruling or order in the proceeding, or on the record of the proceedings.
