NOTICE OF EX PARTE COMMUNICATION BY THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL JUSTICE ALLIANCE

Pursuant to Article 8 of the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) Rules of Practice and Procedure, the California Environmental Justice Alliance (“CEJA”) and Central Coast Alliance United for a Sustainable Economy (“CAUSE”, a member organization of CEJA) hereby file this notice of the following oral *ex parte* communication in the matter of A.14-11-016.

On May 18, 2016, Gladys Limón and Shana Lazerow, attorneys for CEJA, participated in a telephonic *ex parte* communication with David Gamson, Advisor to Commissioner Peterman. The call began at approximately 11 a.m., and ended at approximately 11:20 a.m. Ms. Lazerow explained CEJA’s position, that NRG’s February 2016 letter showed a change in facts underlying the Track 1 determination on which this proceeding is based, and that NRG’s May 2016 letter did not refute the change. Ms. Lazerow further informed Mr. Gamson that CEJA had been granted the right to file a reply in support of its motion to reopen the record. Ms. Limón reiterated CEJA’s concern that, while Commissioner Peterman’s proposed decision acknowledges the importance of environmental justice, it proposes that the Commission address environmental justice in the future, not in this proceeding.

The *ex parte* communication did not include any written materials.
