## NOTICE OF EX PARTE COMMUNICATION

Pursuant to Rule 8.3 and 8.4 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, Kerman Telephone Co. (U 1012 C) ("Kerman") hereby provides notice of the following *ex parte* communications.

On May 12, 2016, Patrick M. Rosvall (Kerman's attorney), David Clark (Kerman's Regulatory Manager), and Rhonda Armstrong (Kerman's Vice President of Operations) (collectively, "Kerman Representatives") met with Advisor to Commissioner Florio, Jessica Hecht at 801 Capitol Mall Sacramento, California. The conversation started at approximately 9:10 a.m. and lasted for approximately ten minutes. No written materials were exchanged in connection with the meetings. In this conversation, the Kerman Representatives asked about Ms. Hecht's opinion of the oral argument, which occurred on the Commission meeting on May 12, 2016. The Kerman Representatives asked if there were any follow up questions that Ms. Hecht may have following the oral argument. The Kerman Representatives asked about the possibility of reopening the record in light of the Commissioners' questions during the oral argument. The Kerman Representatives inquired about the status of any potential revisions to the Proposed Decision and confirmed that their concerns about timing of this case were resolved through obtaining interim rate relief. Finally, the Kerman Representatives thanked Ms. Hecht for her attendance at the oral argument.
